FIVE GRANTS FOR THE MASTER'S PROGRAM IN PURE AND APPLIED MATHEMATICS AT THE UAM

The Departament of Mathematics offers 5 grants for the Master program in pure and applied mathematics of the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, under the following conditions:

Duration: 12 months (october 2013- september 2014)

Funding: Recipients will receive an allowance of €1000 per month (from October 1st 2013 up to September 30th 2014) and will receive a compensation for the tuition fees for the program. Travelling expenses are not covered, but students in special circumstances may contact the master's coordinator coordinador.master.matematicas@uam.es to seek partial funding for travel.

Aims and conditions: Recipients must follow the studies of the Master's Degree in Mathematics and Applications in the academic year 2013-2014.

Eligibility: Applicants are required to have a Graduate degree in Mathematics, or to be in the last year of the undergraduate studies. In this latter case these studies must be completed by the time the Master's courses at the UAM begin.

Profile: These grants are aimed at students in Mathematics with a good academic record. Applicants should include the list of the courses taken in their undergraduate studies, together with the marks obtained. A reference letter from a faculty member of their Departments is also advisable.

Selection procedure: The Comisión de Posgrado of the Department of Mathematics of UAM will be in charge of the selection of candidates on the basis of academic excellence.

Application Deadlines: Applications for these grants should be submitted between February 15th, 2013 and May 20th, 2013 to the following e-mail address: <u>coordinador.master.matematicas@uam.es</u> (please indicate BECAS MASTER as subject). The appropriate application form can be found in the Department's home page <u>www.uam.es/matematicas</u>.

Decision: The final decision will be announced on May 31st 2013 in the Department's website <u>www.uam.es/matematicas</u>. Within 15 days of this announcement the successful applicants must send a letter of acceptance to the coordinator of the Master Programme, or an email with the scanned letter to <u>coordinador.master.matematicas@uam.es</u>.

Selected candidates must also apply for admission in the Master in Mathematics and Applications of the UAM through the on-line application tool provided by the <u>Centro de Estudios de Posgrado</u> of the UAM, when the enrollment period opens.
