Financial support for visitors

The Department of Mathematics offers support for short-term visits of mathematicians from other institutions to our Department.

Duration: From 1 to 3 months between September and December 2012. The total number of months financed by this program will not exceed 6.

Funding: 4.000 € monthly. The cost of health insurance (mandatory), travel and lodging is included in this figure, but these expenses are tax free. The remaining amount will be subject to the existing international tax agreements.

Aims and conditions: The visitors are expected to contribute to the research activity in our Department and to interact with the members of the staff as well as with the graduate students. They will be asked to deliver a number of lectures (in English or Spanish) in the form of seminars or mini-courses addressed to graduate students (to a total number of about 8 hours per month of stay). Researchers visiting the Department under this scheme should remain in the UAM during the period of the visit except for short absences to attend a conference or similar activities.

Eligibility: Mathematicians from institutions based outside the region of Madrid. Preference will be given to those coming from foreign centers. The application will be submitted by a permanent faculty member of the Department and should consist of a presentation letter indicating the dates of the proposed visit, a copy of the candidate's CV and a description of the activities that would be carried out during the visit.

Selection procedure: The selection of candidates will be made by the Comisiones de Posgrado y Profesorado of the Department of Mathematics of UAM on the basis of the candidate's scientific career and the potential contribution of the visit to the success of current research projects in the Department as well as to the research training of graduate students.

Application Deadlines: Applications for a visit should be submitted by 20th May 2012 to the following e-mail address: adolfo.quiros@uam.es (please indicate CONVOCATORIA DE VISITANTES as subject). Shortly a new submission period will open for applications for visits in 2013.
